



## **ANF Student Internship Program 2010**

Dear Publishers,

The Arkansas Newspaper Foundation is announcing the fifth annual student internship project for the summer of 2010. Information will be sent to journalism programs at all Arkansas colleges and universities with active departments as well as other departments such as English or political science departments if requested. We believe that this program will benefit newspapers directly by providing paid internships to students who are interested in the newspaper industry. We hope to encourage students to work at the newspaper and to enjoy a positive experience during their internship. Priority will be given to Journalism students in their Junior and Senior year of higher education.

There are four (4) matching funds opportunities available from the Arkansas Newspaper Foundation. The Arkansas Newspaper Foundation will be providing \$1,510.92 to four (4) member newspapers who agree to match the funds for compensation for the paid intern position up to \$1,500.00.

Interested newspapers must complete the attached application form and return it to the ANF prior to February 19, 2010. The four newspapers that are selected to participate in this program will be notified on or before February 26, 2010. Interviews and intern selection should be completed by April 2, 2010.
