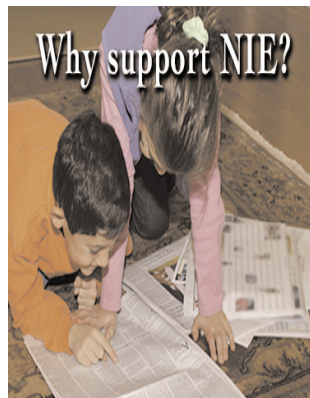
LEAD PRESS OPERATOR
